Summary of changes to bus services in Cotswolds North & Central

from 13 November 2011

How is my bus service changing?

All bus services subsidised by Gloucestershire County Council have been reviewed as part of the Council's spending review.

There will be little if any change on most routes. In some cases improvements have been made by re-timing buses to improve connections and opening up possibilities for journeys that were not easy to make before. For others, particularly on less used services, changes could include a reduced frequency or the need to change buses.

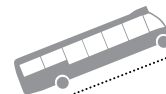

Changing buses and through tickets

To maintain as much of the current network as possible with reduced funding, some services will now connect with others to get you to your destination rather than go there directly, so you may have to change buses.

To make changing buses as easy as possible we have:

1. Designed the new timetables to reduce waiting times whilst guaranteeing connections where through routes are replaced by connecting buses. Services will be timed to get to the interchange point in plenty of time and the driver of the connecting service will know to wait for the other service to arrive if it does happen to be running late.
2. Introduced through tickets on subsidised services to your destination. A through ticket can be purchased on the first bus you use and this will be accepted on the next bus on your journey.

New timetable with guaranteed connections to/from Cheltenham service 801 at Bourton-on-the -Water.

Bourton-On-The-Water - Upper Oddington - Moreton-In-Marsh (subsidised) 803

Revised timetable.

Temple Guiting - Cheltenham (subsidised) 804

New timetable running between Temple Guiting and Andoversford where guaranteed connections will be made to and from Cheltenham. There will be an early morning and early evening bus to/from Cheltenham Monday-Friday. Shopper buses to Cheltenham from Andoversford to run on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

Bourton-on-the-Water - Banbury (not subsidised) 806

No change.

Clapton On The Hill - Cheltenham (subsidised) 809

New timetable running on Saturdays and extended to serve Windrush and Little Barrington instead of service 833. Connections to/from Cheltenham available at Northleach.

Stow-On-The-Wold - Kingham - Cheltenham (subsidised) 810

Revised timetable running between Upper Oddington and Bourton-on-the-Water where guaranteed connections will be available to/from Cheltenham.

Salford - Cheltenham (subsidised) 811
