
Dear Chris,

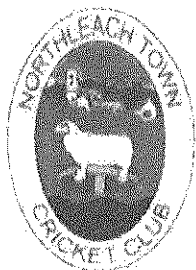
As far as the new running club, that we have been building up for the last two years, we would be able to use this for training, summer and winter. We would also be able to expand to include athletic/running training for children.

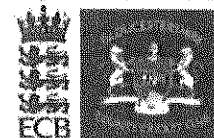
