

THE COTSWOLD HALL



The Cotswold Hall is an important part of the history of the town. It began life in 1886 when it was known as Northleach Institute. The building was given to Northleach by a benefactor, Mrs. Elizabeth Stephenson. It is “owned” by the people of Northleach and is managed on their behalf by a number of Trustees.

The Hall received a significant facelift in 1894 with the erection of an additional storey; other rooms were added and the library converted to a snooker room. In 1897 the large period clock was installed as a celebration of Queen Victoria’s Diamond Jubilee.



The Cotswold Hall has recently undergone major improvement work. It now has new ladies, gentlemen’s and disabled toilets and, in addition, the entrance porch, stairways, Vicar’s Room, Main Hall, both kitchens and the bar have all been refurbished and decorated. A lift makes access to both floors easy for the disabled and elderly people with difficulties. The Hall is ideally situated – a central position on the main street of the town.

In addition to the Main Hall, Bar Room and Vicar’s Room – all available for hire – there is a Snooker Room, open to members and guests from Monday to Saturday.
