115. Public Conveniences Provision

To note that Cotswold District Council has established a Task and Finish Group to review the provision of public Conveniences in the district, discuss the possible impact on the Town, and agree on the Town Council's representation.

Members felt that the public conveniences are important to the town and should remain open. Reasons given included:

- The impact on public health, which was apparent when the toilets were closed during the covid lockdown.
- The provision of toilets supports business and tourism, and the position of Northleach as a local service centre. The town is busier than 10 years ago, with increased tourism overspill.
- It is the only disabled toilet in the town centre as many historic local buildings have steps.

It was RESOLVED that this Council feels the public toilets are important to the Town and would be willing to explore all options for keeping the toilets open.

Cllr Jackson agreed to represent the Council in this matter.
